



DISTRICT WISE CLIMATE CHANGE INFORMATION FOR THE STATE OF TAMIL NADU TEMPERATURE PROJECTIONS FOR THOOTHUKUDI



31.1 About Thoothukudi

Thoothukudi traditionally known as "Pearl City" on account of the prevailing Pearl fish in the past. The district is situated in between latitude 8°4' and 9°27' and longitude 77°45' and 78°20' with an area of 4621 sq. km. It is a coastal district and is is bounded by the districts of Tirunelveli on the north, the districts of Virudhunagar and Ramanathapuram, on the east and by Gulf of Mannar on the south-east and by Tirunelveli district on the west and south-west. 1,2,3

31.2 Climate of Thoothukudi

The district enjoys a hot tropical climate. The annual mean minimum and maximum temperature are 23°C and 29°C respectively. The climate is conducive for Agricultural and Horticultural crops. Average temperatures of January is 27°C, February is 27°C, March is 29°C, April is 31°C, May is 31°C. ^{2,3}

31.3 Temperature Projections for Thoothukudi

The annual maximum and minimum temperature normal (1970-2000) of the district are 32.9 °C and 24.5°C respectively.⁴ Projections of maximum temperature over Thoothukudi for the periods 2010-2040 (2020s), 2040-2070 (2050s) and 2070-2100 (2080s) with reference to the baseline (1970-2000) indicate an increase of **1.0°C**, **1.9°C** and **2.8°C** respectively. Similarly,the projections of minimum temperature for the same periods indicate an increase of **1.1°C**, **2.2°C** and **3.2°C** respectively.




Fig 31.1 Changes in Max. Temperature for 2020s, 2050s & 2080s




Fig 31.2 Changes in Min. Temperature for 2020s, 2050s & 2080s

Parameter	2020s	2050s	2080s
Maximum Temperature	+1.0°C	+1.9°C	+2.8°C
Minimum Temperature	+1.1°C	+2.2°C	+3.2°C

31.4 Key Findings

The average change of maximum and minimum temperature for Thoothukudi district are expected to increase by 2.8°C and 3.2°C respectively by the end of the century.
